Have your say on registration standards for paramedics

Consultation is open on the first registration standards for paramedicine which will become a registered health profession in late 2018.

What you need to know

There are five mandatory registration standards that all paramedics will need to meet to become registered with the Paramedicine Board of Australia.

- 1 English language skills
- 2 Criminal history
- 3 Professional indemnity insurance arrangements
- 4 Continuing professional development
- 5 Recency of practice

The Board is also consulting on a registration standard regarding grandparenting provisions for paramedics who don't have an approved or accepted qualification. This standard will provide pathways for these practitioners to demonstrate that they are qualified for registration as a paramedic.
